- Migration, FDI and trade: network effects
- Institutions and international trade

Topics on Mediterranean Trade/Area/Issues

- Exporting firms: advantages and disadvantages of a Mediterranean location
- Policies for trade in underdeveloped areas
- *Infrastructure endowment for trade (what's more needed?)*
- Across Mediterranean trade (features and obstacles)
