Presentation

The 1st edition of the **Brixen Summer School Workshop on International Trade and Finance** will be held in Bressanone/Brixen from September 14 to September 19, 2009. The 2009 edition will be divided into two parts: the **Summer School** from the 14th to the 18th of September, and an **International Forum** on September 19. The Summer School will consist of a set of lectures on **Recent Developments in International Trade** and of presentations of research work or research projects by participants. The International Forum is being planned for September 19, will be devoted to a comprehensive discussion of problems of current interest and should be attended by policy-makers and experts in the field of international trade and finance.

The general aims of the Brixen Workshop are:

- to provide advanced training in international economics and international political economy for PhD students, postgraduate students and young economists from all countries;

- to broaden the horizons of young scholars on the relevance of the economics of international trade and finance for understanding the problems and opportunities associated with current trends in the world economy and with the advancement of global economic integration;

- to allow young economists to meet fellows from different countries with a common interest in the theoretical and political problems of the world economy.

The Brixen Workshop consists of two sections. On is devoted to lectures focused on advanced topics in the economics of international trade, finance and globalization as well as on presentations of dissertations or research projects by participants. The other consists of an international Forum. The Forum is open to the public and is focused on the most recent events and problems of international trade, finance and globalization as well as on the policies needed for fostering the advancement of economic and financial integration at a continental or worldwide level.

The official language of the Brixen Workshop is English.


Location

Travel

How to reach Bressanone/Brixen:

Closest airports: Innsbruck (Austria); Verona; Munich (Germany); Venezia; Milano; (Linate or Malpensa); Brescia



By plane + train:

If your flight is to **VERONA** : take the train from VERONA/PORTA NUOVA to BRESSANONE. Frequency of trains: one per hour; averaged duration: 2:10 h.;

If your flight is to **MUNICH** (GERMANY): take the train from München Hbf to BRESSANONE via INNSBRUCK/BRENNERO. Frequency of trains: one per two hours; averaged duration: 3:30 h.

If your flight is to **VENEZIA**:: take the train from VENEZIA/MESTRE to BRESSANONE via VERONA. Frequency of trains: almost one per hour; averaged duration: 3:50 h.; possible changes: Verona.

If your flight is to **ROME**: take the train from ROMA/STAZIONE TERMINI to BRESSANONE via FIRENZE/BOLOGNA/VERONA. Frequency of trains: almost one per two hours; averaged duration: 7 h.; possible changes: Bologna .

If your flight is to **INNSBRUCK**: take the train from Innsbruck Hbf to Bressanone/Brixen via Brennero. Frequency of trains: one per two hours; averaged duration: 1:40 h.
