

Rimini is a city with an overabundant hospitality offering, with moderate prices compared to other locations. The size of the city makes getting around relatively easy. The Campus of the University of Bologna (UniBO) is just three blocks from the train station, and there is a trolleybus system with dedicated and separated lanes (the so-called “Metromare”) that connects the central train station with the coastal urban areas (where many of the hotels and other accommodations are concentrated), essentially reaching all the way to Riccione.

For those seeking recommendations, we can suggest the hotel that is, logistically speaking, the most convenient due to its proximity to both the train station and the campus. It is the facility that typically hosts UniBo guests attending seminars and conferences, and it offers extremely reliable service.
